**A QUICK EVALUATION STUDY REPORT ON  
TRYSEM (S R D A) IN  
MOKOKCHUNG DISTRICT.**

**DIRECTORATE OF EVALUATION GOVERNMENT OF NAGALAND

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### **INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND.**

1.1. The programme of TRYSEM is implemented by the state Rural Development Agency. This scheme is to equip the rural youth of the age group of 18 to 35 years who are below the poverty line by imparting them with necessary skills and technology to enable them to seek self-employment. Another important arm of TRYSEM, is to have a de-centralised industry by encouraging to start a small, tiny and cottage industries in the rural area by those trainees. This scheme is not only important for development of industries in the state but also is expected to solve to some extent the unemployment problem of the state.

### **1.2. TRYSEM TRAINERS UNDER DIFFERENT TRADES.**

The numbers of the trainers from 1986-87 to 89-90 is only 121 under different trades. In the year 1986-87 there was only 14 trainers under 4 trade. During 1987-88 there are 40 trainers under 5 trades and in 1988-89 there are 30 trainers under 9 trades and during 1989-90, 37 trainers have been selected for 6 trades. The total numbers trained during

1986-87 to 1989-90 are 49 under knitting, 15 Radio electronic, 1 Carpentry, 35 Motor Mechanic, 1 Handicraft, 2 Bakery, 3 Type writing, and 2 Tractor Pump set Repairing. Thus the total numbers of Trainers trained during 1986-87 to 1989-90 are 121.

### 1.3 OBJECTIVES OF THE EVALUATION STUDY.

This study was taken up in accordance with Sl.No.II of the minutes of the D.P.B meeting held on 8-10-90. The board desired that an Evaluation study be Conducted to assess the present position of the trainees and to see whether the Training helps them in getting employment.

### 1.4 METHODOLOGY.

The numbers of trainees during the last 4 years data are Collected from the Deputy Project Officer, (S.R.D.A.) Mokokchung for the purpose of this study. Out of a total of 121 trainees only=45, trainees were interviewed through a structured questionnaire to ascertain his position and views.

### 1.5. LIMITATIONS.

Due to lack of transport facilities and poor Communication system it is not possible to have a wider sampled. In spite of our best effort it become extremely difficult to interview those trainees who are residing in the most interior area in such a short time.

## CHAPTER-II IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAINING PROGRAMME.

2.1 Trade-wise position of persons trained and the amount of subsidy and loan given during the period 1986-87 to 1989-90 are presented in a tabular form below :

2.3 Out of 9 (nine) Trainers, who received the subsidy/loan, SI. No. 1,2& 4 of the Table - 1 are not running their unit. The rest are however running their respective Unit. The working of those Unit are not evaluated in this quick study.

2.4 Out of the remaining 112 persons who have not been given any assistance 42 persons were interviewed to know whether they have get any Govt. job or self-employed. Their views and expectation are presented in a tabular form below:-

**CHAPTER - III  
MAIN FINDING AND RECOMMENDATION.**

3.1. In course of field investigation it is found that Shri Viyito, Sema of Athuphomo Village who is recorded as a beneficiary under TRYSEM by giving him subsidy and loan is reported that he has not taken any Training in any trade nor he received any subsidy and loan from Government. But later through enquiry by Shri. Viyito, Sema with the village elders it was found out that another person from the Village have taken the subsidy amount and loan in the name of Shri Viyito, Sema. This showed that something goes wrong in the implementation. This need to be checked immediately.

3.2. It was also found that Smti. Awala she who has received the full amount of subsidy and loan, is not running her project. She is settling in Dimapur. Similary Smti. Kilemsungla was given a subsidy amount of Rs. 5000/- and a loan of Rs. 9000/- But she too did not start any Unit nor intended to start the Unit

3.3 The Training seems to be defective in view of the fact that all the trainers are awaiting Govt. job by holding the certificate awarded to them. Most of them are not aware that the training imported on them are meant for self employment. The present systems seems to be not very much successful and need review of the system and content.

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
